Articles should be a maximum of 5000 words, shorter contributions are also welcome. All articles will be peer reviewed prior to publication.

Notes and updates on current research projects (up to 500 words) are welcome.

PhD abstracts of ongoing or recently completed work are encouraged, please send text up to 300 words and include thesis title and name of supervisor/s and host institution.

Notification of recent publications will be added to the Bibliography section

All contributions should be sent as unformatted .doc files in Times New Roman 12pt, picture captions should be included with the text and bibliography should be in Harvard format.

Picture files should be sent separately from the text with at least 600dpi resolution, a map of the area discussed in an article must be included.
